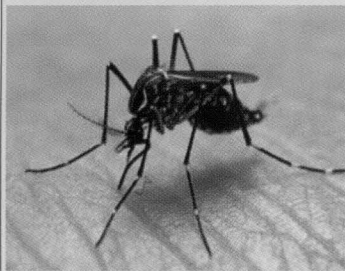


PREVENT INVASIVE AEDES MOSQUITOES IN AND AROUND YOUR HOME

The Invasive Aedes mosquitoes can transmit Zika, Dengue, Yellow Fever and Chikungunya.



Aedes aegypti

(Yellow Fever Mosquito)

Small dark mosquito with stripes, forming a harp shape on the mid-body and white banded legs.



Aedes albopictus

(Asian Tiger Mosquito)

Small black mosquito with a bright white stripe on the front of the mid-body and bright white banded legs.

These species BITE AGGRESSIVELY and:

- Are capable of transmitting diseases.
- Prefer backyard urban environments including anything that holds water for more than 3-4 days.
- Bite both outdoors and indoors during the day.
- Usually breed in containers, laying eggs just above the water line.

Prevention Methods:

- Dump, drain or scrub small containers that hold standing water.
- Remove all standing water from your yard.
- Keep pool and pond recirculation systems functioning properly.
